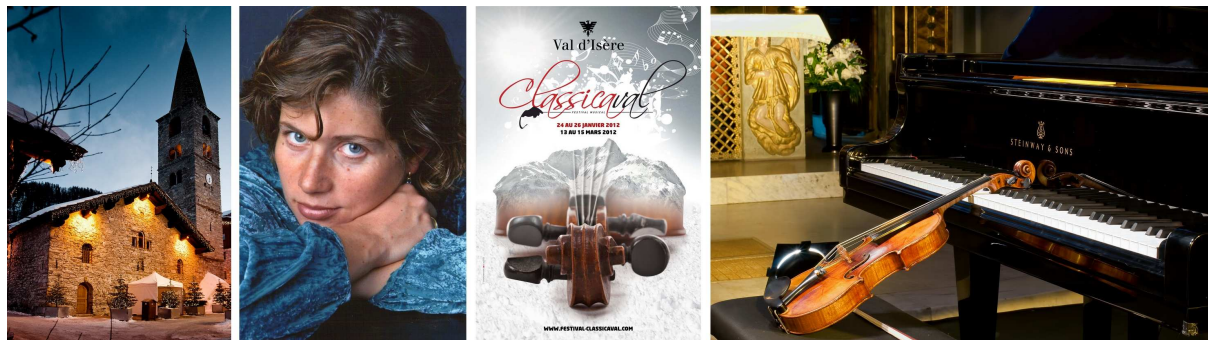

Classical music comes to Val d'Isère *Classicaval, 2nd Opus: 13th-15th March 2012*



Classical music lovers take note...Val d'Isère's Classicaval Festival, which runs from 13th- 15th March 2012, is not to be missed.
